



POST-SUTURE INSTRUCTIONS

For the Next Week:

Continue to change the bandage twice a day with the same ointment unless instructed otherwise. If you begin to get allergic to the topical antibiotic ointment, (skin becomes red, itchy and slightly weepy) switch to Aquaphor Healing Ointment.

In One Week from suture removal through the Next Month:

Unless instructed otherwise, you may stop bandaging your wound beginning 1 week after your sutures are removed. However, continue to keep the wound moist twice a day with a thin film of Aquaphor Healing Ointment for one month.

Your wound site will go through many changes as it heals over the next several months. Please call our office if you have any concerns.
